EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86
Series of 2020

“AN ORDER PRESCRIBING OFFICE UNIFORMS FOR ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANDA, PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 18, S1997, pursuant to CSC Resolution No. 97 – 3334 dated July 7, 1997, the Civil Service Delegates and / or affirms the authority to Head of Department, officials of the National and Local Government to issue, adopt and implement rules and regulations governing their respective proper office attire or uniform, subject to the guidelines prescribed in the CSC Memorandum Circular No. 14, S1991;

WHEREAS, CSC Memorandum Circular No. 14, S1991 provides that the office uniforms as prescribed by the different government agencies/ offices shall be the official attire of all government officials and employees which shall be worn in accordance with the assigned schedule;

WHEREAS, the use of tight fitting, seductive, micro – mini and gauzy/ flimsy/transparent dresses by female and employees shall be prohibited;

WHEREAS, CSC M.C. No. 25, S1991, provide that the Dress Code applies to both male and female employees in the civil service subject to the following distinctions:

- a. The wearing of “maong” pants among male employees is allowed provided that the same is worn with collared T – shirts;
- b. The wearing of maong among female employees is allowed only on instances when these employees are regularly performing their duties and functions in field, or if temporarily assigned in actual field operations. In other words, female office workers are not allowed to wear maong.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOGANIE C. RARANG, Municipal Mayor of Anda, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby prescribed the official attire of all government officials and employees which shall be worn in accordance with the assigned schedule as follows;

SECTION 1. Official Attire for Male Officials and Employees:

Tuesday - Color code "Pink" and proper office attire
Wednesday - Color code "Gray" and proper office attire
Thursday - Color code "Black" and proper office attire
Friday - Color code "Blue" and proper office attire

SECTION 3. Officials Attire for Male Job - Order (J.O)

- Monday - Color code "White" and proper office attire
Tuesday - Color code "Pink" and proper office attire
Wednesday - Color code "Gray" and proper office attire
Thursday - Color code "Black" and proper office attire
Friday - Color code "Blue" and proper office attire

SECTION 4. Officials Attire for Female Job - Order (J.O)

- Monday - Color code "White" and proper office attire
Tuesday - Color code "Pink" and proper office attire
Wednesday - Color code "Gray" and proper office attire
Thursday - Color code "Black" and proper office attire
Friday - Color code "Blue" and proper office attire

SECTION 5. SANCTIONS:

To ensure strict compliance of the wearing of prescribed uniform, penalties to be imposed in accordance to M.O. No. 13, S2001 signed on April 16, 2001.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
