EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 89

DECLARING EVERY 10TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER AS SPECIAL NON - WORKING HOLIDAY IN COMMEMORATION AND THANKSGIVING TO SAINT NICHOLAS DE TOLENTINO, THE PATRON SAINT IN THE ISLAND TOWN OF ANDA, PANGASINAN.

WHEREAS, in the year 1842, settlers discovered a big, unnamed forested and inhabited island about 55 square miles, situated Northwest of Lingayen Gulf and uniquely surrounded by 13 - small island;

WHEREAS, the island was named CABARRUYAN, derived from the word CABARRIOUAN (barrio mates) and later became a barrio of Bolinao. Every Holy week, inhabitants in the barrio had to march to the town proper to join the celebration. Every Sunday too, people had to go to Bolinao to hear mass;

WHEREAS, the new town named Cabarruyan was registered bearing the date of July 15 - 17, 1851. On January 20, 1852, they started the construction of the plaza, church, tribunal, convent, cemetery and street and took more plan a year to establish the new town.

WHEREAS, from then on, the town people of Anda continuously celebrating Holy mass every 10th day of September in honor of Patron St. Nicholas de Tolentino in held at Poblacion, Anda, Pangasinan.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOGANIE C. RARANG, Municipal Mayor of Anda, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order;

SECTION 1. DECLARATION

Every 10th day of September as Special non - Working Holiday in commemoration and thanksgiving to Saint Nicholas de Tolentino, the Patron Saint in the island of town of Anda, Pangasinan.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect immediately.
