

S-PASS LGU Anda, Pangasinan Inbound Travel Requirements

If your travel purpose is for tourism, please select Local Tourist, do not apply as Local Worker.

If your travel purpose is for going home, please select Returning Reside. Etc. Each traveler has its own requirements.

PLEASE SELECT YOUR TRAVELER TYPE ACCORDING TO YOUR TRAVEL PURPOSE ONLY.

-----TRAVELER TYPES AND CORRESPONDING REQUIREMENTS:-----

RETURNING RESIDENTS

1. Valid or Government-issued ID indicating home address in Anda, Pangasinan.

Note: in the absence of such IDs, please provide Certification of Residence (usually granted after a minimum of 6 months continuous stay) from destination barangay. Letter of acceptance & Birth Certificate will not be acknowledged for the time being.

LOCAL FILIPINO WORKER

1. Company Id or Certificate of Employment indicating home address in Anda, Pangasinan, and company address that is outside Anda, Pangasinan.

Note: in the absence of such certification of employment, please provide company ID plus certification of residence from destination barangay. Letter of acceptance or Birth Certificate will not be acknowledged)

TOURIST

- a. For Day Trip tourists (until curfew hours only):
 - Proof of residence in non-restricted area (such as ID, which will be left at the checkpoint as assurance and claimed before curfew hours)
 - TaraNa.ph QR with a Day Trip approved application to Anda, Pangasinan
- b. For Tourists with 1 day (24hrs including overnight) duration of stay or more:
 - Proof of residence in non-restricted area (such as ID); and
 - Proof of booking from an authorized accommodation (official list provided by the Tourism Officer).

INDISPENSABLE AND HUMANITARIAN CASE TRAVEL

1. Valid or Government Issued Identification Card
2. Any one of the following:
 - a. For scholastic purposes/government exam/licensure purposes:
 - Proof of appointment/enrollment form/permission letter from school head stating purpose
 - b. For legal/documentary purposes (such as but not limited to land, securing permits & licenses, adoption, etc.)
 - Permission letter from the concerned office stating purpose (signed by head)
 - c. For marriage rites purposes (strictly immediate family only)
 - Permission letter from destination barangay

d. For religious purposes

- Permission letter from local church head stating purpose.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS
FOR ALL TYPES OF TRAVELERS COMING FROM OUTSIDE OF PANGASINAN**

1. One fully accomplished COVID-19 Health Declaration Form (must be latest version, available for download at <http://www.andapangasinan.gov.ph/services/downloadables/>) Must be duly signed and dated no more than 3 days (72 hours) before travel. [3]
2. Any of the following:
 - a. Certified negative result of RT-PCR Swab Test from a legitimate laboratory (valid only for 72 hours (3 days) from the date of release, must still be valid on the date of travel)
 - b. Certified negative result of Antigen Rapid Test from a legitimate laboratory (valid only for 48 hours (2 days) from the date of release, must still be valid on the date of travel)
 - c. Vaccination card for individuals who have received the second or final dose of their vaccines at least two weeks prior to travel.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Because of the time-based validity of some requirements, all are advised to apply no more than 3 days (72 hours) before travel. All pending applications will be processed within 24 hours, and early applications will be automatically cancelled. **Please note that there is no processing outside of office hours.**
2. Medical certificate WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED as replacement for COVID-19 Health Declaration Form, while the COVID-19 Health Declaration Form is required by Anda's municipal border. (medical certificate is not required [2])
3. For travelers coming from the ECQ/MECQ and NCR, NON-APOR travel is not yet allowed. This is in effect until upon the issuance of new quarantine classifications and travel-related executive orders.

EXCEPTIONS

For travelers within Pangasinan (i.e., other municipalities or cities), only valid ID, preferably showing address or along with other proofs of residence within Pangasinan, is required. There is no need for S-PASS.

**PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT THESE TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS
ARE MANDATORY AND WILL BE CHECKED ONE BY ONE. THANK YOU FOR COMPLYING.**

OTHER IMPORTANT TRAVEL REMINDERS:

1. Any person below 18 y/o & over 65 y/o, including persons w/ comorbidities, are required to remain in their residences AT ALL TIMES, except for emergency or humanitarian cases. [1]

2. Wearing of face masks AND face shields is mandatory outside own residences. [1][3]
3. Curfew hours: 8:00 PM - 4:00 AM. [1]
4. All single motorcycle riders, both driver and passenger, residents, APORs and tourists alike, must be wearing helmets properly while on the roads of Anda, Pangasinan. [3]
